

PEURTO VALLARTA AIRPORT INSTRUCTIONS

- As you are leaving Peurto Vallarta Airport, there will be many car company workers and timeshare works asking if you need a car/shuttle service.
 - DO NOT ACCEPT. DO NOT STOP TO TALK TO THEM. KEEP WALKING.
 - Puerto Vallarta's airport is a Federal area and taxis have special permits and pay extra taxes and licenses, so they charge more than the normal taxis in Puerto Vallarta. About \$100 USD

 - If you are able to make a 5-8 minute walk with your luggage, you can get a taxi/uber for \$30-\$40.
 - If you prefer to have a private car pick you up at the airport, it's about \$100-\$122 USD.

- Order the Uber - before you leave the airport
 - just so you can connect to the airport WiFi, in case you have trouble connecting to your international data plan
 - *If you don't already have Uber set up on your phone, make sure you download it on your phone and enter your credit card information before you leave the airport.*
 - UBER WILL NOT PICK YOU UP ON THE AIRPORT PREMISES.
 - You must walk over the bridge that goes over the highway
 - As you exit the airport, take a sharp left, and walk over the bridge, it's about a 5-8 minute walk.

 - Your Uber driver might speak English, he might not.
 - He will have the destination location in the system and will take you where you need to go, regardless.
 - Download the Google Translate App
 - So you can communicate if need be.
 - Within the app, you can also *download the Spanish language* so you can use the app even if you don't have cell service!
